with the surrealistic circus theater piece: Being confuses consciousness

The Dada Circus tells modern fairy tales; sometimes funny, sometimes touching, but always bizarre. They skillfully navigate between familiar clichés and total imagination. They combine acrobatics, juggling, object manipulation, dance, and their own style of "physical theater." In this play, a surreal love epic unfolds between a transsexual ballerina and an asexual wobbly creature. They contort themselves acrobatically, give birth to status symbols of the bourgeois nuclear family, and fight over juggling clubs.
