Workshop: The Triad of Political Struggle Practice of Change - Change of Practice

What fundamental conditions are necessary for the transformation to a non-hierarchical and egalitarian society? What basic principles regarding work and distribution are desirable and necessary? What changes in the mode of production are needed to avert the impending climate catastrophe? How can a system of collective economic activity be developed? And what organizational foundations are needed beyond that to build a liberated society?

Participants will develop fundamental insights based on prepared questions. The speakers will provide brief inputs on a question, which will then be discussed in an open discussion and lead to the next question. We will be guided by the concept of the "triad of political struggle": the three poles of analysis, goal, and path are "in constant flux, relate to each other, and thus create a dynamic dialectical process." (Pankahyttn 2020, p. 28)

"The Classless Post-Capitalist Society" serves as a guide and compass. Drawing on the tradition of socially critical movements with transformative practices, theoretical concepts have been reviewed for relevance and modernized. In order to overcome oppression and exploitation, fundamental insights into social structures and alternative models are needed, as well as diverse concepts for transformation.

The workshop gives participants the opportunity to work through the content themselves and thus engage intensively with the fundamentals and issues at hand.
